Ants, elephants, hippos, lions and polar bears. A visit to Copenhagen Zoo at Frederiksberg is always a wild and exciting experience. Zoo at Frederiksberg in Copenhagen houses over 3,000 animals, which together make up 264 exciting species. Regardless of the weather, Zoo offers tropical tropics experiences in Tropezoo. Snakes, crocodiles, silkberries, rhino birds, daisies, free-flying birds and butterflies are just a bit of what you can experience in the 1,500 m2 rainforest. In 2008, Zoo received a new elephant house, designed by the architect Norman Foster. The house is considered one of the best elephant houses in the world. Here the animals can be seen close up, for example, when they bathe in the water grave, it is deep enough for them to dive all the way down, so that only the snatches get up. In 2013, the Arctic Ring opened, giving you a unique opportunity to come close to polar bears, North Atlantic birds and seals above and below the water surface - completely unparalleled in Europe.
