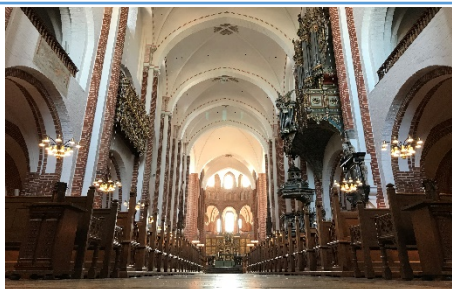


ROSKILDE CATHEDRAL

All of Danish history are gathered here under beautifully decorated vaults and in dark crypts. Here 40 kings and queens of Denmark are buried, so you can explore the entire Danish Royal history in one place.



Roskilde Cathedral was the first Gothic Cathedral in Scandinavia made of bricks.

With its many royal unique chapels, the cathedral is also a mirror of the changing European architectural history and at the same time a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
